



Consumption of Alcohol Policy

1. The Combined Counties League acknowledges that all football clubs serving alcohol on match days have a responsibility to ensure that match participants and spectators are able to enjoy their football without hindrance from alcohol-related incidents. To ensure that this is the case the following policy must be adhered to by all members.
2. NO alcohol, or any drinks (alcoholic or otherwise) in glass bottles, or glasses, should be allowed immediately adjacent to the pitch itself where they could be used to cause damage or personal injury.
3. Consumption of alcohol can be allowed in grounds where there is a designated area provided, such as an outside patio, so long as there is a clear boundary to indicate where the area ends, and it is not within the immediate vicinity of the pitch.

Such an area must be clearly signed and, if necessary, stewarded on match days to ensure compliance.

4. Members failing to comply with this policy will be dealt with by the competition.
